- Administers medications and treatments as necessary in the school setting
- Documents First Aid and illness care provided to students. Completes accident reports, and maintains an accurate log of classroom health-related activities
- Collaborates with lead nurse to recommend exclusion and monitor readmission to school for students with infectious or communicable diseases
- Maintains medical equipment and supplies in the school
- Provides student personal health care, assistance, and supervision as needed
- Collaborates with parents and lead nurse to develop and implement individual health care plans for students
- Provides emergency care in cases of injury or sudden illness. Such care will be limited to first aid only, followed up by referral to family physician or proper medical facility
- Maintains an accurate health record on each student. Documents health-related activities and treatments on daily logs as appropriate
- Demonstrates knowledge of, and the ability to administer medications appropriately, in keeping with school policy on administration of medication in school
- Provides assistance with student's education program as directed by the program manager
- Participates in all aspects of classroom program as directed by the program manager
- Assists with the maintenance of the classroom supplies including cleaning and care of equipment
- Identifies health and safety hazards in the classroom and advises teacher
- All other duties as assigned by Program Manager or Lead Nurse
